## **ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS**

The United Nations Headquarters is located in the heart of New York City on 1st Avenue between 42nd and 48th Street. This 18-acre site is an international territory that belongs to 193 Member States of the United Nations. The Visitors Entrance, and access to the Delegates Dining Room (DDR), is at 46th Street and 1st Avenue.



## Please be prepared to go through United Nations Security screening upon entering and follow these steps to reduce wait time:

- Bring your government issued photo identification (can include a passport, drivers license or national identity card)
- Bring PubMatic-issued conference pass
- A PubMatic representative will greet you at the Visitors Entrance
  upon showing your ID and confirmation pass, you will be given a UN security pass
- You will then enter the security screening area which will include going through a metal detector. Coats and hats must be removed; shoes stay on. Please do not bring liquids, food, pointed objects or weapons of any kind
- PubMatic representatives will then direct you through the grounds and up to the DDR. You will be required to present your ID and UN security pass twice before arriving to the DDR
